


Our students come from a wide range of backgrounds and cultures and this has provided a unique opportunity for all of us to appreciate diversity and the many cultures in the world around us.

At Yale Primary School, we are committed to providing the highest standard in education for your child, but importantly we approach education holistically – we want to nurture emotional and social development along with their growing minds.

We teach a range of subjects (in addition to the basics of numeracy, science and literacy) such as physical education, music and languages and are proud of the seamless way we incorporate information communication technology (ICT) into classroom learning.

Numeracy

Our whole school maths plan focusses on building students' understanding and knowledge in a fun way that is transferable across many subject areas. Your child will be challenged, motivated and perhaps even excited to learn.

Science
