In STEAM, Year 1 students have explored both recycling and absorbent materials prior to making these wonderful 'Self-watering Planters'. Using recycled plastic bottles, string and water, these planters allow the water to be absorbed up through the string, keeping the roots of the plant hydrated. Students thoroughly enjoyed completing this project and they have made beautiful displays in the Year classrooms.

A3 BALLOON ART

The students in A3 have created beautiful mixed-media Hot Air Balloon Art. They started by colouring in their balloon templates using coloured pencil and then added detail using texta. Students then explored hot and cool colours and chose which they would use to create the watercolour painted backgrounds.

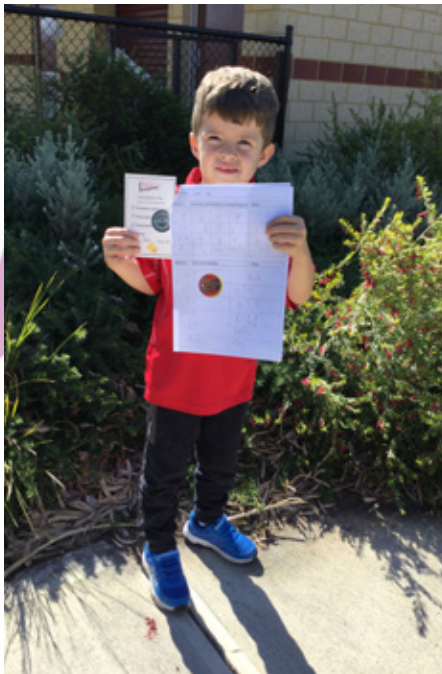
